<u>Tests:</u> After each unit we will have a **cumulative** test which will include both multiple choice and short answers. To earn full credit, all work and explanation for answers must be shown.

<u>Quizzes:</u> Students will take quizzes to show how well they know the material and their ability to use the skills/topics discussed in class. To earn full credit, all work and explanation for answers must be shown. While tests come at the end of every unit, quizzes can come at any time. On average, you will have one quiz per week.

<u>Homework and Classwork:</u> Students will occasionally be given classwork to be completed in class. Homework Checks can be assigned after any homework assignment.

<u>Classroom Participations</u>: Students with good class participation will see it reflect both in the class participation grade and in their grasp of the material. Warm ups and exit ticket grades are included.

<u>Academic Honesty/Plagiarism</u>: All student work MUST be original and not copied in any way from other sources including print, computer, internet or other student's work.
